Add co-authors

Adding co-authors is a good way to let others know you’re now on Google Scholar. Use the “Add co-authors” to suggest co-author to your profile (you can only add co-authors who have already created their own Google Scholar profile). Track your citations

Google Scholar is a useful tool to track citations of articles. Google Scholar reports the citation counts per publication as well as more advance metrics. For author-level metrics, Google Scholar includes: citation counts, *h*-index, *i10*-index and the Cited By measures, they are all located on the right column of the profile page.

The ***h*-index** measures the productivity and impact of a scholar’s published work, using the author’s most cited articles and the number of citations they have received in other publications. It is one way that people can quantify their impact on a field of study. The ***i10*-index** is a simple measurement which shows how many of an author's papers have 10 or more citations.

- Track total citations per year of my articles (Click “View All” link over the citation in my public profile page)
- Review my *h*-index and *i*-10 index measures.
