Access Scopus

1. Go to [Ruth Lilly Medical Library Databases](https://iupui.libguides.com/az.php?s=83627).
(<https://iupui.libguides.com/az.php?s=83627>)
2. Scroll down to click on **Scopus** or click “**S**” on the alphabet bar.
3. NOTE: You may need to enter your IU username, passphrase and DUO.

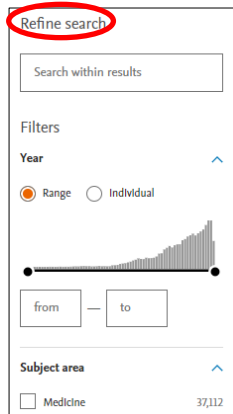

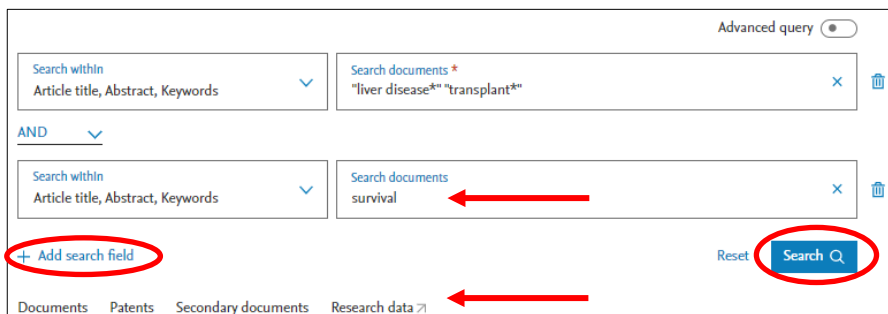

2. Click on the **Sort by** drop-down arrow to change how the results are sorted.
3. Click on **Show all abstracts** to read article abstracts

Fine-tune your topic search



1. Narrow the search using any of the options provided under **Refine search** on the left-hand side of the screen. After choosing an option, click on the **Exclude** button or **Limit to** button.



2. **Add a search field** with a new topic.
3. Narrow to **Documents, Patents, Secondary documents** or **Research data**.
4. Click on the **Search** button.

Find Full Text of an article

1. Use the Find It Button **Find It** to check if full text is available.
2. If no full text is available, click on [Ruth Lilly Medical Library Content Management & Delivery](#). (You may need to log into the service with your IU username and passphrase.)

Export, Print, and Save Scopus references

1. Click on the check box next to each article citation to export, print, and/or save.
2. Click on the:
 - **Export arrow** to export
 - **Download link** to then print
 - Under **More**, click on **Save to list** to save the chosen references in Scopus. NOTE: When Saving to a list, you will need to sign into and/or create a free Scopus account.
